## New Publications

The following Revenue statistics have been recently released.

### [Help to Buy Statistics](#)

The Help To Buy (HTB) incentive, announced in Budget 2017 is designed to assist first-time buyers with the deposit required to purchase or self-build a new house or apartment to live in as their home. The statistics in this newly published document are based on analysis of applications and claims in respect of the HTB incentive. The statistics include an overview of the application and claims process and a geographical breakdown of claims. Updates to these statistics will be published regularly.

## **Employment and Investment Incentive (EII) Statistics 2012-2016**

The Employment and Investment Incentive (EII) is a tax relief incentive scheme which provides for tax relief of up to 40% in respect of investments made in certain corporate trades. The EII replaces the Business Expansion Scheme and will run until 2020. The statistics in this newly published document are based on analysis of EII returns and focus on the latest EII figures at 31 December 2016 for the period 2012–2016. Updates to these statistics will initially be published on an annual basis.

The statistics showing the estimated tax cost of various property based incentives and reliefs.

### **Sporting Bodies with Tax Exemption**

A list of sporting bodies that have been granted tax exemption under Section 235, Taxes Consolidation Act, 1997.

### **Bodies with Charitable Tax Exemption**

A list of bodies that have been granted Charitable Tax Exemption under Section 207, Taxes Consolidation Act, 1997.

### **Resident Charities and Approved Bodies – Tax Relief on Donations**

A list of Resident charities authorised under the Scheme of Tax Relief for Donations to Eligible Charities and other Approved Bodies under the terms of Section 848A, Taxes Consolidation Act 1997.
