[Income Distribution Statistics](#)

The 2015 Income Distribution Statistics (IDS) for Income Tax and Corporation Tax are now available directly through [CSO Statbank](#) or by navigating from the [Statistics Menu](#) page. The addition of the 2015 IDS data means that income distribution profiles of Income Tax and Corporation Tax are now available in many cases for the 12 years from 2004, in a format which enables user to electronically interrogate the data to meet their specific needs.

[Help to Buy Statistics](#)

The Help To Buy (HTB) incentive, announced in Budget 2017 is designed to assist first-time buyers with the deposit required to purchase or self-build a new house or apartment to live in as their home. Since early 2017 Revenue has published a weekly report providing statistics regarding applications and claims in respect of the HTB incentive. From July the Help To Buy report will be published on a monthly basis, issued in the first week of each month (similar to the HRI report) . The monthly report will mirror the current report in terms of content. The last weekly report will be published on 30th June and then the first monthly edition will be published in the week ending 7th July 2017.
